Each year, I am given multiple opportunities to teach teachers how to use technology in their classroom. To date, I've taught over 1500 teachers across Ontario. To accompany the ideas I regularly share in workshops, I often attach photos and videos to enhance these ideas. For example, one workshop I've taught more than a dozen times is how to use Skype in the classroom. It's always helpful to show them pictures and video illustrations of live Skype calls done with my own classes.

I post these videos to my own **YouTube** channel (YouTube Search-- **Teaching Smarter**) and then share the videos and links to my personal YouTube channel with the teachers I teach. I also have a website (www.TeachingSmarter.ca) that's been visited by 40 countries that drives traffic to my YouTube channel.
